HOW TO:



ADD HOLES FOR A CHAIN OR KEYRING

- 1. Start with your offset path ('Offset Path' worksheet)
- 2. Click the black arrow this is your selection tool
- 3. Draw a box around the Hello text to select both outlines
- 4. In the top toolbar, click the padlock to prevent stretching your design
- 5. Type in your preferred width or height in mm

This design is 50mm in width


- 6. Click on the **Create circles**, ellipses and arcs tool in the left hand sidebar
- 7. Click on your page and drag to draw a circle
- 8. Click the black arrow this is your selection tool
- In the top toolbar, type in a width (W) and height (H) of 3mm
- 10. Click the padlock to keep both dimensions the same



- 11. Click on the circle and move to the top left corner of the larger outline
- 12.Go to the **Path** menu and click **Linked Offset**
- 13. A white diamond should appear at the top of the circle
- 14. Click on the diamond and drag outwards to enlarge the circle.


 Don't pull too far.
- 15. Draw a box around both circles to select
- 16.Go to the **Edit** menu and click **Duplicate**


2 new circles will appear on top of the original circles.

17. Move the 2 new circles to the right hand corner of the larger outline.

Hold control on your keyboard to keep them straight.

- 18. Click on your blank page to deselect the circles.
- 19. Hold shift \(\subseteq \) on your keyboard and click on the larger 2 circles and larger outline to select



20. Go to the **Path** menu and click **Union**



- 22. In the **Stroke** tab click **Flat Colour**
- 23. In the Fill tab, click No Paint
- 24. In the **Stroke style** tab type in 0.1mm.
- 25. Click on the inside hello text and move below the larger outline

Now your holes are added and you can laser cut your design!
