## **HOW TO:** OFFSET A PATH



- Start with your joined-up text ('Join up text in Inkscape' worksheet)
- 2. Go to the **Path** menu and click **Linked Offset**
- 3. You should see a white diamond appear at the top of your text
- 4. Click on the diamond and drag outwards to enlarge the text like in the image. Don't pull too far.
- 5. Click the black arrow this is your selection tool.
- 6. Click on the new larger shape and move below the Hello text.
- 7. Go to the **Path** menu and click **Object to Path**
- 8. Go to the **Path** menu and click **Break Apart**
