Appointment system

- Only come to The Factory if you have a confirmed booking or meeting with a member of staff and please adhere to the times of this booking. We cannot accept drop-in visitors at this time or the guests of booked visitors.

Building Precautions

- While every effort is being made to ensure your safety during our refurbishment, we are still a work in progress. Please be mindful of any additional hazards, dust and noise and let us know if you require any additional assistance.

COVID Precautions

- Do not enter the space if you or someone you have been in contact with has COVID symptoms or you have been asked to self-isolate. - Please check-in on the NHS COVID-19 Track and Trace QR code on arrival at The Factory.
- Keep your distance from other people (2 metres apart where possible, 1 metre as an absolute minimum but with extra measure in place and with the consent of the other person).
- Unless exempt, please wear a face covering when using machines, moving around the Factory and liaising with our technicians or other people in the space (please bring your own but if you forget we have some spares). The face covering must cover your mouth and nose. Please take your face covering away at the end of your session for disposal or cleaning
- Please do not eat meals in the space (refreshments are permitted, please bring your own). There are outdoor benches available to eat your lunch around the Business Park.
- We will ask you to clean kit and workstation with the antibacterial spray provided at the end of your session.
