Who is it for?

The course is **completely free**, although there are a limited number of spaces available.

To apply, you must be part of an underrepresented group in the digital design, fabric and construction industries and live in Bristol, South Gloucestershire, or Bath and North East Somerset. Underrepresented groups include but are not limited to:

- Women and gender minorities
- People from Black, Asian and minority ethnic groups

However, you can also apply if you live in South or East Bristol and fulfil one of the following criteria:

- You have been unemployed for a long period of time
- You are in precarious employment
- You have been disproportionally affected by COVID-19









Course Overview

The Future Makers courses are a mixture of in-person workshops at <u>KWMC The Factory</u> and self-led learning at home through our virtual learning platform. There are support slots with our technicians offered throughout the home-learning weeks if you get stuck with the software, or want some feedback on your creative ideas.

The first two courses are only distinguished by the day of the week they are held on (Thursday and Friday). The Retreat course is slightly different, starting with two longer in-person workshops, followed by a shorter period of home learning and then finishing with a 3-day 2-night residential retreat.

After registering for the course suitable for you (links found at the end of this document), we will send you a form so if you do not have access to a computer or laptop at home, please state it there and we will be able to provide an option to access computers at KWMC or The Factory during the week.
