EPISTEMIC INJUSTICE

see M. Fricker (2007)

- **All knowledge is equal...**
...but we all know that some knowledge is treated more equally than others.
- **Testimonial Injustice**
Whose knowledge or expertise is valued (and whose isn't)
- **Hermeneutical Injustice**
Unequal access to and understandings of knowledge
